POST EXPOSURE EVALUATION AND FOLLOW UP

EXPOSURE INCIDENTS

The following is a list of exposure incidents that must be reported to and documented by the UTILIZING EMPLOYER AND DENTAL/MEDICAL ASSOCIATES, INC.

- * Contact of blood and other infectious materials with non-intact skin
- * Needle stick injuries or other puncture wounds with contaminated objects
- * Spraying or splashing of blood and other infectious materials in eyes and or mucous membranes
- * bites occurring in the performance of work activities

EXPOSURE INCIDENT PROCEDURE:

In the event of an exposure incident the following procedure must be followed:

- * Wash or irrigate with water plus or minus soap
- * Report incident to the UTILIZING EMPLOYER or their INFECTION CONTROL REPRESENTATIVE and follow their Exposure Incident Procedure.
- * Document all circumstances of the exposure incident
- * Notify DENTAL/MEDICAL ASSOCIATES, INC. of the incident.
